



### **School Hours**

School hours for Junior Kindergarten to Grade 6 are from 9:00 a.m. to 3:15 p.m. Students are permitted on school property after 8:45 a.m. Most students are dropped off at 8:45 a.m. to ensure they will be ready for class on time.

### **Transportation**

Students are responsible for their own transportation to and from the school. Information about private school bus companies is available at the office. Public transportation is nearby.

### **Lunch & Recess**

Students bring a lunch and snack to school. A “hot or cold lunch” programme is available for purchase 5 days per week. Microwave ovens are available in each classroom for student use.

There is a morning recess with supervised outdoor play and a second outdoor period following lunch. The school is equipped with both an enclosed and non-enclosed play area, grass field, and sand box. A second, paved area is used for ball games and activities.

### **Trips & Outings**

Educational trips and outings are an important part of the Counterpoint Academy™ experience. Each class will have at least one or two special experiences per month, which may include trips to the National Arts Centre, Museums, or in-school visits from authors and musicians. In addition, students in Grades 3 to 6 go on a class overnight excursion each year.

### **Concerts**

Public speaking and self-confidence go hand-in-hand. These important skills are encouraged through assemblies and concerts, which take place in December and June. Music, poetry, French and drama are all showcased at these special family events.

### **Homework**

Homework assignments are designed as part of the overall curriculum. Parents are encouraged to support their child with homework assignments. Each student is responsible for completing the work to the best of his or her ability. Junior and Senior Kindergarten students may receive small, occasional homework assignments. Students in Grades 1 through 6 expect homework daily. Approximately 10 to 20 minutes of work is added per grade level.
